


SPARE ME: Scan the piece! Predict the topic! Annotate as you read! Read the entire question! Eliminate wrong answers! Make an Educated guess!




STRATEGY 2: IN "ALL OF THE FOLLOWING EXCEPT" QUESTIONS, MARK CORRECT ANSWERS.




STRATEGY 3: HELP YOURSELF WITH "GO BACK AND READ LINE ____" QUESTIONS BY LOOKING AT SENTENCES BEFORE AND AFTER THE LINE.



STRATEGY 4: SOMETIMES YOU CAN GROUP ANSWERS; THAT THEN MAKES ELIMINATION EASIER.



<u>STRATEGY 5</u>: ANTECEDENT AND "REFERS TO" QUESTIONS ARE ONLY ASKED IF REFERENCE IS DIFFICULT. <u>GENERALLY</u>, RULE OUT THE CHRONOLGICALLY FIRST AND LAST.
